Although born in Germany in 1879, Mr. Kalmbach felt deeply privileged to experience the freedoms and cultural diversity of America. Therefore, he bequeathed his twentytwo-acre homestead as a place for others to gather and appreciate the freedoms and profound wonders of our American heritage.
